Information/Updates

Dr. Elliot presented years of service pins to Kenny Stroud and Summer Odom. Kenny has 25 years and Summer has 20.

Dr. Elliot announced that he will not seek a third term as Department Head. This decision came after multiple discussions over many months with Dr. Hussey. He will remain as Head until a new person has been identified. There will be an international search conducted immediately.
