Open discussion about the course content of ALEC 641 and ALEC 646. Is there duplicate content covered in ALEC 645 and ALEC 623 or ALEC 625? Determined more discussion needed to take place on this sequence.

Motion was made by Julie Harlin to "Refer the review of the course curriculum and evaluation of the international ag courses to the International Ag workgroup and provide feedback to the Graduate Faculty at next meeting." Seconded by John Rayfield. Motion passed.

The Chair sought volunteers. Manuel Pina agreed to take the lead for the committee. The Chair charged the committee to: 1) convene a meeting of those interested in International Agricultural Development, 2) to locate and review a) the existing ALEC 641-646 courses, and b) any curriculum plans developed by the International Agricultural Development (Dr. Wingenbach was former Head – Dr. Shinn is current), 3) to propose a curriculum (a rotation of course offerings) in International Agricultural development, and 4) deliver a report of the progress during each Graduate Faculty meeting until the review is complete.

2) Departmental By-Laws – Tim Murphy

No report at this time. James Lindner reminder that some documentation was provided in the past. Committee is ready to meet. Meetings will be scheduled following the Move.

New Business

1) Shared definition of departmental teaching load

The University requirement for Faculty Workload for those on 100% academic funding is 9 Teaching Credits per long semester. Each undergraduate course generates 3.0 Teaching Credits, and each graduate course generates 4.5 Teaching Credits. Alternatives to Classroom Teaching Credits, called Equivalent Teaching Credits (e.g. Research, Advising, Graduate Committee Service, Course Revision, etc.) can be used to account for some proportion of the Teaching Credits requirement. Equivalent Teaching Credits do not count automatically and must be negotiated with Dr. Elliot.

Faculty Workload needs to be more clearly defined and communicated throughout the Department. A systematic method of requesting Equivalent Teaching Credits needs to be developed. The faculty needs to develop a shared vision of Faculty Workload and the basic definition of Equivalent Teaching Credits and share with Dr. Elliot.

Faculty Workload will be included on the next Graduate Faculty Meeting Agenda as a discussion item.
