Action/Discussion Items

- 1) Approval of Minutes from the January meeting - Tim Murphy  
**Motion was made by Scott Cummings, Seconded by John Rayfield to “Approve the January minutes as distributed.” Motion passed unanimously.**
- 2) Graduate Admissions Reviews (February 1 deadline) – Tim Murphy  
**An open discussion was held about the admission of each applicant. Faculty will have until March 5 at 5:00 pm. to review applicants, vote, and indicate whether wish to be an IMA (interim major advisor). Although the ALEC criterion score is not used to determine Auto-admit applicants, it was requested their criterion score be included on the summary spreadsheet. Clarice will update for the next review cycle.**

**A second review process for Fall 2012 will be after the June 1 deadline. This meeting has not been scheduled.**

- a. **GPA calculation for Auto-Admit – Dr. Murphy mentioned a possible concern -- an applicant currently attending (not TAMU, other institutions) is reviewed by calculating the last available 60 hours of undergraduate work or Masters work. This calculation could place an applicant in the Auto-Admit category when, once the final grades are received, the individual’s GPA was below the Auto-Admit criteria. Waiting for final grades will delay all applicants. Faculty present agreed to continue to review based on this “best available” GPA data.**
  - b. **Criteria Data Spreadsheet – The graduate admission data spreadsheet will no longer be sent to all for review through email. It will become accessible on the, secure, Graduate Application Review section in AIMS, as a link to a pdf file.**
- 3) Graduate Student Funding for Fall 2012 – Tim Murphy  
**Dr. Murphy led an open discussion of two questions. 1) Should the current State-Funded Assistantship package be retained, resulting in fewer GA positions, or reduced to maintain a similar number of positions? 2) Should we continue the practice of automatic 16% raises between first and second year of GA positions?**

**One question was, how many State-Funded Assistantship positions are there? Dr. Murphy explained, in recent history, there have been essentially 13 Masters’-Level State-Funded Assistantship positions divided among the three workgroups 5 ALED, 4 AGCJ, and 4 AGSC. Doctoral positions are essentially 1.5 masters’. In 2011, funding for these positions was reduced by 15%; essentially two positions. Some of this loss was overcome by writing 9-month rather than 12-month commitments, but additional adjustments will be required.**

**The consensus was to attempt to maintain a similar number of State-Funded Assistantship positions to cover the current teaching load, and to eliminate automatic raises in favor of performance-based incentives. Dr. Murphy will adjust the offer packages to accomplish these goals.**

- 4) Graduate Curriculum Committee Report – Gary Briers – **No report at this time.**
  - a. International Ag Course Rotation – Manuel Pina – **Dr. Pina was not present. No report.**

### Informational Items

1) Distance courses/Distance Programs - Tim Murphy

**The 650 “in absentia” sections we have used in the past for variable-credit distance-delivered courses (e.g. 684, 685, 693, 691 and 692 courses) have been eliminated; replaced by 700 and 720 sections. If a student is enrolled in a distance degree program, MAG and D@D, the Registrar will no longer allow these students to enroll in “in absentia” sections. They must enroll in 700 (TX resident) or 720 (out-of-state/country) sections. Clarice will request these sections to be created through the Registrar at the time the forms are received and process the registration as she has in the past.**

2) Advertising for Graduate Assistants – Tim Murphy

**Dr. Murphy mentioned that other institutions are beginning to advertise graduate assistants positions. He wanted all to be aware that he, too, would be sending out an advertisement. These are not “new” or “extra” positions, just the ordinary churn of the graduate assistant pool.**

**Dr. John Rayfield moved to adjourn. Seconded by Scott Cummings. Meeting adjourned.**
