- 1) Approval of Minutes from the April meeting Tim Murphy Motion was made by Gary Briers, Second by Tracy Rutherford to "Approve the April minutes as distributed." Motion passed unanimously.
- 2) Qualifying Examinations for Campus Doctoral Students Tim Murphy, Gary Wingenbach Open discussion. Dr. Wingenbach feels that a qualifying exam should be part of the campus doctoral degree programs because it is a good indicator of the students' competency. The D@D program already has one in place, and the same format could be used. Possibly specific research courses could be taken prior to completion of 30 credit hours, and these courses would then be part of the qualifying exam.
