Action/Discussion Items

- 1) Approval of Minutes from the April meeting.

**Motion was made by Gary Briers, Seconded by Robert Strong to “Approve the April minutes as written.” Motion passed unanimously.**

- 2) Graduate Curriculum Committee Report – Gary Briers

- a. Faculty “Stewardship” of Course Rotation – (Attachment A)

**Gary Briers proposed to provide faculty with a list of courses taught per semester without stewards. Provided as Attachment B. Discussion of ALEC 695 rotation.**

1. International Ag Course Rotation – Manuel Pina

**Manual Pina was not present. He is still collecting information. No report at this time.**

- 3) Appointment to Graduate Faculty (Deborah Dunsford-Vita, Attachment C) – Tim Murphy

**Open discussion. There is a need in the AGCJ specialization, due to retirement of Dr. Starr. Option to review as a Full Member or Adjunct Member to Graduate Faculty.**

**Motion was made by Gary Wingenbach to “Propose faculty vote to submit request as an Adjunct Member for approval to Graduate Faculty instead of Full Member.” Seconded by Julie Harlin.**

**A secret ballot took place and ballots were collected. The majority vote was to submit a request for Deborah Dunsford to be placed on Graduate Faculty as an Adjunct Member. Paperwork will be submitted for review at next Graduate Program Committee meeting, May 18.**

- 4) Faculty Work Load – Tim Murphy

**Open discussion. Questions rose referencing what faculty can count as work load, what is automatic and what is negotiated. Suggestions were made that the definition should be part of Departmental By-Laws in comparison of the University policy on faculty workload.**

**Motion was made by James Lindner to “Establish a committee with Kim Dooley as chair, to put together a white paper document indicating and addressing what faculty load is, how to access, what counts as load to meet compliance and recommend it to the By-Laws committee.” Seconded by Tracy Rutherford.**

**Motion passed unanimously.**

**Tim Murphy asked Kim Dooley to recommend members for the committee. She asked for volunteers representing all levels of faculty. Lori Moore, Chanda Elbert and Gary Briers volunteered. This committee will report at the September meeting.**

5) June Graduate Faculty meeting – Tim Murphy

**Due to the move, complete admission materials will not be available for the scheduled June meeting. Rather than scheduling two meetings, a new date for the June Graduate Faculty meeting was proposed.**

**Gary Briers moved to “Change the June Graduate Faculty meeting to June 20, to include the discussion of the applicants meeting the June 1 deadline.” Seconded by Traci Naile. Motion passed unanimously.**

**James Lindner mentioned that it is important to evaluate and vote on all candidates for admission, not just those that you have been in contact with.**

**Alvin Larke discussed students Interim Major Advisor (IMA). Students are assigned a faculty member to be their IMA, however, sometimes students elect to work with other faculty members. There is a form available for students to complete to change their IMA. This form is not always completed, and Degree Plans are filed with another faculty member as Chair of the committee. Dr. Larke would like faculty approached to Chair a committee to contact the student’s IMA.**
