### **Classroom Efforts**

### ALED 334- Leadership of Volunteers

This course is an upper level course introduces fundamental concepts of volunteer development and leadership by studying human relationships. The course aims to identify and understand the role of volunteers in nonprofit organizations, identify and understand the role of volunteer administrators in nonprofit organizations, unpack the GEMS model of volunteer management, and gain leadership skills necessary to create a positive organizational culture within volunteer programs. This course is pragmatic in its approach and one that can be used in volunteer organizations no matter what the application. Class sessions include an examination of theory, conceptualizing, reflection, and application.

ALED 339 – Agricultural Extension Philosophy and the Land- Grant Mission This upper level course covers the philosophy of Cooperative Extension and Extension's role within the Land-Grant system. History, organization, program areas and guiding principles of the Cooperative Extension System are covered in order to enable students to understand how Cooperative Extension facilitates positive change at a grass-roots level in the areas of agriculture and natural resources, family and consumer sciences, 4-H and youth development, and community and economic development. This course is yet another way to develop future extension service professionals by harnessing their understanding how agricultural knowledge has been utilized within the Cooperative Extension system to improve Texas, the United States and the world.

ALED 441-Agriculture Extension Organization and Methods.

This upper level course covers the Organization, principles and processes used by the Cooperative Extension System to help people increase knowledge, develop skills, adopt practices, and change behavior for self-improvement, individual action, and community problem-solving. This course is yet another way to develop future extension service professionals by harnessing their understanding how agricultural knowledge has been utilized within the Cooperative Extension system to improve Texas, the United States and the world.
