Be Sure to Bring:

- Sleeping Bag & Pillow

*Bedding and towels are **NOT** provided –*

- Clothing-
 - Both Indoor & Outdoor Activities- closed toed shoes
 - Fun Night - Recreational attire (tennis shoes, shorts)
- Toiletries – towel, toothbrush, toothpaste & soap
- Steno Pad - writing utensils

Print Out and Complete the necessary forms and bring them to Check-In.

- Medical Waiver Form
