## Animal Science Change of Major Requirements

## The following requirements must be met in order to be accepted into the Department of Animal Science:

- 1. TAMUG Students must have a minimum of 27 credit hours earned.
- 2. Complete the required paperwork:
  - a. Change of Curriculum Request
  - b. Essay stating why you want an Animal Science Degree and how an Animal Science Degree will help you meet your career goals
  - c. Unofficial Transcript (printed from Howdy)
- 3. Complete the following requirements:
  - a. For Production/Industry Option:
    - Have at least a 2.75 overall GPA at Texas A&M.
    - Have completed BIOL 111 or CHEM 119 (CHEM 101 & CHEM 111)
    - MATH 140/141, MATH 142 are highly preferred.
  - b. For Science Option:
    - Have at least a 3.3 overall GPA at Texas A&M.
    - $\bullet~$  Have completed CHEM 119 (CHEM 101 & CHEM 111).
      - \*\*Grade of "B" or better is preferred
    - CHEM 120 (CHEM 102 & CHEM 112), MATH 140/141, MATH 142, and BIOL 111 are highly preferred.

## **Important Notes**

- Typically, students with more than 75 semester credit hours will not be allowed to change majors into the Department of Animal Science.
- Students who are seriously interested in ANSC and may not meet all requirements are encouraged to inquire accordingly.
  - You are applying to a specific option. You may **not** change options after you are admitted.
  - Walk-in advising hours for change of major students are held every Tuesday 9-11am and 1:30-4pm.
