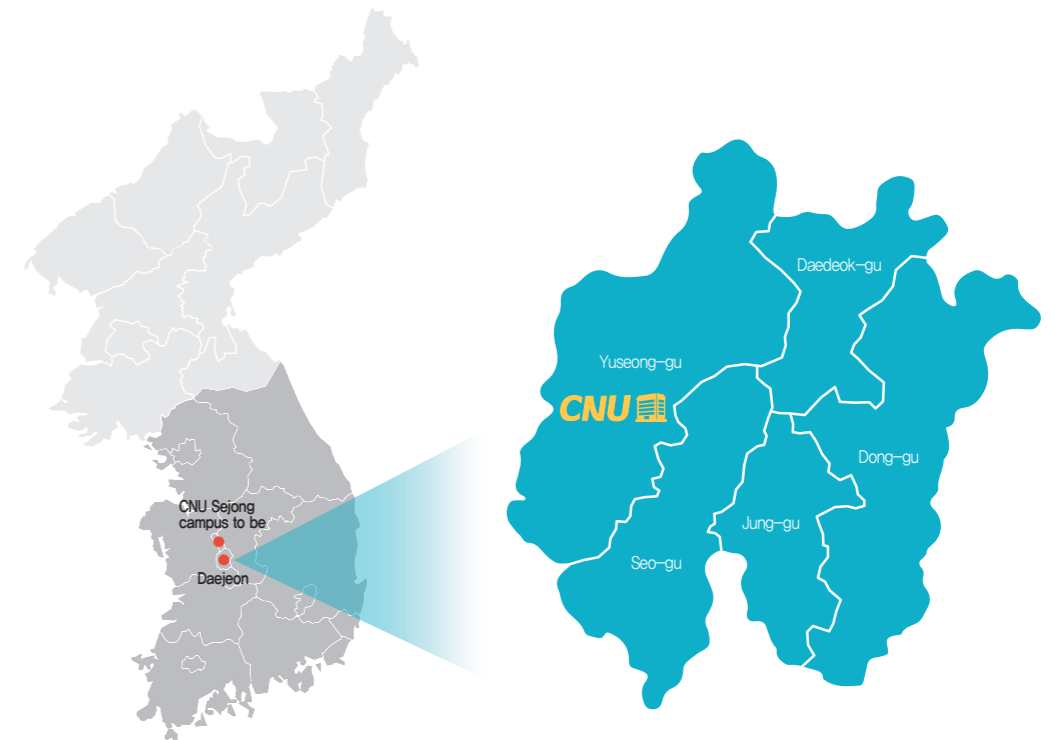


ABOUT CNU

Home ballpark of Hanwha Eagles Professional Baseball team



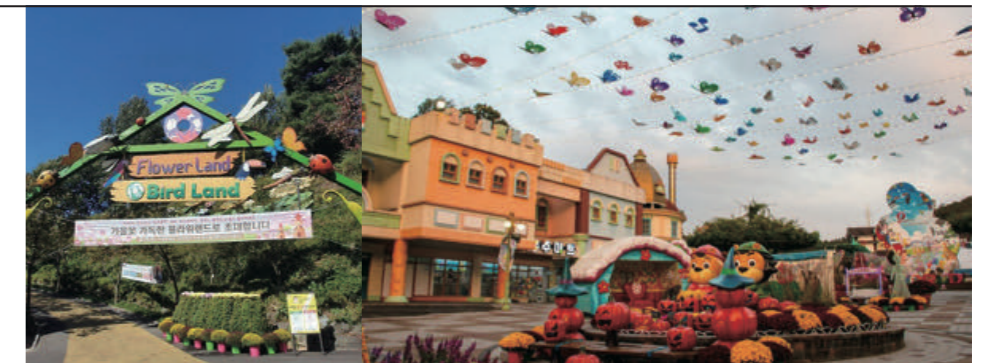

Chungchong National University is established, unifying Chungnam Provincial University with Chungbuk Provincial University.

March 1 1963
Chungnam National University is reorganized as a separate institution from Chungbuk University.

March 13 1964
College of Law & Business Administration is established on November 30, 1967 College of Medicine is established.

July 1 1970
Started to move into the Daedeok campus

July 1 1972
University Hospital is built and opened.

March 1 1991
College of Veterinary Medicine is established.

April 3 2006
The office of International Affairs is relocated and opened

March 30 2005
National Cancer Center at Chungnam National University is established

February 10 2004
CNU Industrial-Academic Cooperation Team is established

September 1 2001
College of Agriculture is reorganized as the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences

March 1 2000
Patent Law School is established

August 20 1994
Chungnam National University is selected as a State Policy University

STUDY ABROAD AND EXCHANGE PROGRAM

Exchange program

Students from partner institutions with exchange agreement can study at CNU for a semester or a year with tuition waiver. Depending on agreements, there may be other benefits such as accommodation fee exemption or free intensive Korean Language course.

Summer & Winter Program

- Summer Session for International Students (SSIS)
 - 6 Credits
 SSIS is a 4 weeks summer program for students having interests in attending academic courses and experiencing Korean culture. It provides prestigious lectures and diverse activities such as visiting Seoul(experiencing K-POP culture), National Science Museum and making traditional seal and more.
- Winter for International Learners & Leaders (WILL)
 - 3 Credits. WILL is the same as SSIS, but it is held in winter for 2 weeks. Students will experience cold Korea and beautiful snow.
 - RIP: 3 Credits. Through the Research Internship Program (RIP) during Summer (Winter), students can have experience from research laboratories and CNU industry partners.



Global Scholarship Program (GSP)

It is a kind of exchange program, with differences in benefits.

[Benefits for GSP]

- Exemptions for tuition fees
- On-campus accommodation fees for a semester.
- 50% off the Intensive Korean Language Course tuition.

Visiting Student Program

Students are able to study for a semester or a year and have to pay for all costs such as tuition, accommodation and others that may be occurred.

Dual Degree Program

Students can be granted double degrees from CNU and their home institution after studying at both institutions for 1-3 year(s) respectively.

★ CNU Korean Language Education Program

Korean Language Course at CNU is designed for international students to be admitted to Korean universities including CNU. The students will learn not only the Korean language but also its traditional/modern culture. More than 2,000 international students attend CNU International Language Education Center every year.



Accommodation

CNU dormitory can accommodate around 5,000 students. Rooms are furnished with a bed, desk, chair, closet and book shelf. Personal bathing items are not provided.

Room Type: studio, hallway, apartment, room for married
 Facilities: Gym, laundry room, cafeteria, stationer, convenience store, dining hall, cafe and others.

International Admission

- General Procedure for International Students (degree seeking)
 - International students who wish to seek a degree from CNU should follow these procedures.
 - An applicant should submit an application form (After completing the online application, print it out) and required documents (Study Plan, Self-introduction letter, Affidavit of Financial Support and other required application materials) to CNU via registered mail.
 - CNU sends "Certificate of Admission" to the successful applicants e-mail
 - Apply for D-2 visa at a Korean Embassy in his / her country
 - Obtain a visa
 - Arrive at CNU in Korea
 - Register to obtain "Alien Registration Card" through Office of International Affairs upon arrival at CNU.

All matters concerning immigration and visa status should be handled with the Office of International Affairs at CNU.

INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (RIP)



CNU will bring brand new Research Internship Program (RIP) to exchange student from partner institutions. Research Internship Program will be offered to student at CNU research laboratories and through CNU industry partners in Innopolis Daedeok, Republic of Korea. The INNOPOLIS is an R&D-led innovation cluster that generates a major driving force for national economic growth by creating national intellectual property and facilitating the commercialization of that intellectual property. Through the program, RIP students will take one course "Baekma Internship" along with 3 or 18 academic credits according to participating time in Summer (Winter) program or Spring (Fall) semester.
